From that starting point they created a true champion-ship golf course that has been enhanced and developed each year.

With a par of 72 over 7,150 yards and constructed on 260 acres of links land, every club in the bag is required to play this championship course.

The award winning Clubhouse is both welcoming and functional with ample changing facilities and a comfortable lounge bar and restaurant, where a wholesome, home cooked meal and friendly chat is always guaranteed. Their location, near the fishing village of Clogherhead, ensures a regular supply of fresh seafood, and local farmfresh produce is the mainstay of our menu. The terrace, which over-looks the coast, is an ideal place to relax on long summer evenings, while the open fire in the lounge provides a cosy welcome after a winter round at Seapoint.

The course also includes a large practice area which includes a putting green, driving range and chipping and bunker play practice area is always available to Members and Guests.
